Excerpt: .at the first Passover it was said, None of you shall go out of the door of his house until the morning, which did not apply to later times; in Egypt it was slain by every one in his own house, while afterwards it was slain by all Israel in one place; lastly, formerly where they ate the Passover, there they lodged, but afterwards they might eat it in one, and lodge in another place. 1 Cor. v. 7, 8. Ex. xxxiv. 18-20; Deut. xvi. 2, 16, 17. Numb. ix. 9-11. Pet. ix. §. Ex. xii. 16; Lev. xxiii. 7; Numb, xxviii. 18. Scripture records that the Passover was kept the second year after the Exodus,² and then not again till the Israelites actually reached the promised land;³ but, as the Jewish commentators rightly observe, this intermission was directed by God Himself.^{4...}
