The second covers copartnership and shows the conversion of the sole proprietorship into the copartnership. The third group brings out the transition from copartnership to incorporation and the accounts and transactions which are common to corporations. Consolidations, mergers, holding companies or trusts, form the subject matter of the fourth group.
